

## STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE 2009/2010

As in the past, the University **requires** all undergraduates registered for nine or more semester hours to have health insurance through either an individual/family plan or the University-offered plan. *International Students*, regardless of classification, are **required** to carry the University-offered student health insurance as a minimum standard of coverage and are **not eligible** for a waiver of the insurance. Exceptions are made only in the case of families with dependents residing in the United States and students on J visas. Enrollment is automatic for all students on F1 Visas.

For undergraduates registered for nine or more hours who have adequate health insurance through a family/individual policy that will remain in effect throughout the 2009/2010 academic year, the TCU-offered insurance can be **waived** on-line beginning April 6, 2009, at <http://healthcenter.tcu.edu>. The **deadline** for waiving the insurance is **September 2, 2009**.

Graduate Students and Undergraduates taking less than 9 hours have the option to specifically **elect** the University-offered plan by entering that choice on-line at <http://healthcenter.tcu.edu> beginning April 6, 2009. Fall coverage begins August 15, 2009 and the **deadline** for electing the insurance is **September 2, 2009**.

**The University-offered Student Health Insurance Plan, AETNA STUDENT HEALTH, is a major medical plan providing coverage for illnesses and injuries that occur on and/or off campus. A summary of the 2009/2010 Plan, which includes a temporary ID card, is given in the *Student Health Insurance at TCU* pamphlet, available in hardcopy after June 1.
